


Open sideboards are made up of standard Lampo units with 7/8" thick fronts and open units with 5/8" thick structure and 45° joints. Sideboards with tops and frames are higher (5/8" and 1 1/4" respectively) than sideboards with finished modular covers. The types of opening available are shown with a code next to the fronts.



STRUCTURAL FEATURES

OPEN SIDEBOARDS WITH UPPER OPEN UNITS WITH EXPOSED COVER

Sideboards with exposed upper Open units CANNOT BE FINISHED WITH FULL SUPERIMPOSED TOPS. The construction with finished modular cover or finished cover (single) and opening with Minimal profile keeps the front panels bound to the structures and aligned with the Open units.

GRAIN DIRECTIONS

For all veneered and melamine finishes with grain, the grain runs continuously between the side panel and cover of Open units. Placing them next to or on top of veneered or melamine Lampo units with horizontal grain changes the direction of the grain and the colour tone.






